

Note: age at onset of bipolar disorder: 2009



Kenniscentrum bipolaire stoornissen

[UTRECHT] Om kennis te bundelen en daardoor te vergroten komt er een nationaal kenniscentrum over bipolaire stoornissen. 'Zeer noodzakelijk', vindt initiatiefnemer Willem Nolen, hoogleraar psychiatrie.

'Het gaat hier om een veelvoorkomende psychiatrische aandoening. Maar toch bestaat daarvoor, terwijl dat wel het geval is voor andere nig aandacht geweest voor bipolaire stoornissen. 'Deels komt dat doordat het om een zeer complexe aandoening gaat met een apart verloop, en deels omdat de heersende opvatting was dat dit wel te behandelen valt met de gangbare antidepressiva.' Tot zijn tevredenheid ziet Nolen daarin een kentering en constateert hij ook dat enkele farmaceutische bedrijven speciale middelen ontwikkelen voor bipolaire stoornis-

Lithium Plus werkgroep zijn nauw betrokken bij het opzetten van het centrum. Ralph Kupka, psychiater in de ggz-instelling Altrecht, zal het centrum gaan leiden. Nolen stelt dat het doel onder andere is alle voorradige kennis te verzamelen over bipolaire stoornissen.

'Daarmee hoop je ook de kennis te kunnen vergroten bij behandelaars, onder meer door op de nog op te zetten website veel informatie en onderzoeksresultaten te plaatsen.'

- Unique element & medication in psychiatry
- Critical role in the treatment of severe recurrent mood disorders for more than half a century
- The oldest still used and essential medication in modern psychopharmacology
- Only agent that fulfils criteria for a mood stabilizer: efficacy in treating acute manic and depressive symptoms and also prevents future manic and depressive episodes


